All Saints marches on.....

The plans for improving facilities at All Saints are progressing well. The architect is drawing up a scheme for improvements to the toilet, heating, storage, and access to make the church better suited to general community use. The plans build on the great work already done by the village a few years ago to renew to the roof and install kitchen facilities etc. A visit has already been paid by representatives of the Diocesan Advisory Committee (essentially the planning authority for approvals to our grade 2 listed building) and we have their approval in principle. Our plans have been discussed with Viridor and we are hopeful of making a successful grant application as well as seeking funding from other trust funds.

The scheme has benefited from the re-formation of The Friends of Herodsfoot Church with a strong band of people willing and able to take on that role. Special thanks to Ian Gordon for convening the group and to Mary Counter for agreeing to act as treasurer. As soon as names are confirmed we will publish the names of all trustees of the new Friends (and I am sure all of whom will be glad to receive fund raising ideas and donations!)

The idea is for the church to act as a public resource and not only a centre for worship. So if you have ideas for using the building do let me know.
