Important info regarding Septic tanks – You will need to register your Septic Tank (as of March 2011). Discharges from septic tanks and small sewage treatment plants are mainly exempt from the need to have an environmental permit, but they will all **need to be registered with The Environment Agency**. Discharges to rivers and streams need to be registered **now** and discharges which go into the ground must be registered by **31 December 2011**.

However, if you leave the registration until this date, you may have a significant delay of up to four months if your discharge is in a sensitive area. This will mean that you do not meet the registration criteria and will require an environmental permit urgently.

You can register free using the online application form - <http://environment-agency.gov.uk>. Left hand side of page – More in Home + Leisure - click and scroll down new page – Register a sewage discharge. Or telephone **08708 506506** for application form. (If you already have a Registration Number – this can be filled in where necessary on the form). Please give any assistance as required to neighbours, in completing this form. Thank you to Bill for the reminder.
