**Update on All Saints Building Works**

**- May 2015**

Plans are progressing for improving opportunities for using All Saints as a community venue.

The parish is going to maximise the open space at the rear of the church and plans are being considered :

To improve heating by installing air pumps for air to air heating which will provide comfortable ambient temperatures in the building.

(Quotation already received and approval of diocesan heating advisor obtained)

To improve the toilet facilities with installation of a composting toilet.

Meanwhile general maintenance continues \_ great thanks are due to Saul Williams for massively improving the paths to church and churchyard. The guttering and drainpipe problems are being attended to.

We urgently need to develop a village association committee that can act as a "Friends" group, independent of the Parochial Church Council, which can help with the planned developments.
