New priest for

Duloe and Herodsfoot.

The Revd Peter Bellenes has been licensed as parish priest for the parishes of Duloe and Herodsfoot. Peter retired from full time ministry in Devon in 2009 and has been helping out with Sunday services at Duloe and Herodsfoot since May last year. Peter, who lives in Harrowbarrow, is married to Alyson and he has two adult daughters, Emma and Charlotte. Looming large in his and Alyson's life are their two granddaughters, Eleanor and Isabelle, who live close by at Trewoodloe.

Having served ten years in Devon Peter retired to Cornwall in 2009 to live at Harrowbarrow. Since returning to Cornwall Peter has helped during vacancies at Torpoint, Antony, Sheviok, Maryfield, Callington, South Hill, Landrake and Botus Fleming.

Peter is no stranger to Cornwall having moved to Dobwalls in 1989 to take up a post as team leader at Liskeard with Cornwall Social Services, later working with the same department in the capacity of senior manager for services for the elderly and disabled and lastly as Head of Training.

Peter studied philosophy at Salamanca (Castile, Spain) and theology at Lincoln. Ordained priest by Bishop Michael Ball at Truro Cathedral in June 1990 Peter was at that time serving part-time with the Liskeard Team Ministry and shortly after moved to Menheniot to assist

the parish priest there. Leaving Menheniot in 1999 Peter was appointed team vicar of Marldon and Berry Pomeroy, in the Diocese of Exeter. Peter has always felt really fortunate to have the support of his wife Alyson.

Peter was delighted to be asked to help during the vacancy at Duloe & Herodsfoot and along with Alyson has got to know the congregations. Needless to say he was even more delighted to be invited in February this year to come out of retirement and dust off the little grey cells. Happy to look after the worship and pastoral needs of the two parishes he also looks forward to wider engagement with the communities of both villages and with the school.
