Better Broadband for Herodsfoot

Thanks to the support of Sheryll Murray MP, Councillor Richard Pugh, the Parish Councils and others, BT Openreach are now taking urgent action to improve our phone service. BT are also planning to connect the village phone box via school hill to an 01503 number – this will mean that if Herodsfoot ever does lose its telephone service again then at least the phone box will still work – vital for 999 etc.

In parallel with the work to improve our phone service, we are talking to **BT** and **Superfast Cornwall** about better Broadband service for Herodsfoot. **They are listening!** – But, we have to demonstrate that people want this better service. So it's vital that as many people as possible register an interest – **please support this by registering – THIS IS EASY TO DO AND THIS DOESN'T COMMIT YOU TO BUYING ANYTHING.
